INTERNSHIP PROGRAMS



Semester Program

Gain professional experience, improve your Spanish, and integrate into *sevillano* work culture. CC-CS works with you to place you in an internship that matches your interests and goals.

The curriculum allows you to maximize your experience by providing you with the language and cultural tools necessary for a productive internship. Aligned with the regular CC-CS semester program, you begin with an intensive language and culture course. During your internship you have regular contact with the Center through meetings with the Resident Director, a 1-credit course in cross-cultural reflection, and an optional 3-credit semester course.

Summer Program

CC-CS offers you the unique opportunity to undertake an intensive 8-week internship, while benefiting from homestays and regularly scheduled cultural trips and activities. A 1-credit language training course helps you to gain the linguistic tools necessary to integrate into Spanish work culture.
